In addition to the workshops we want to include a technique tutorial in this year's ALS Users Meeting. The tutorial should give an overview of all technique areas used at the ALS and is mainly intended for students.

For your tutorial contribution please send an email to the user meeting organizers (alsuec@lbl.gov) with your technique and a short description of your research field and work. Please submit your suggestions for workshops using the provided template also by email to the user meeting organizers.

Proposal template:

- 1. Workshop title
- 2. Organizers and their affiliations
- 3. A short (one paragraph) description of the topical area, why it is timely, and the target audience
- 4. The duration of the workshop (half-day, full-day, 1-1/2 day)

The proposals will be evaluated and selected by the UEC according to their perceived relevance. Given the limited number of workshop spaces available, we may work to combine proposals that have a similar theme. The deadline for proposed workshop submissions is Friday, May 15.
